1. Short description of the event – relation with ENACT

The aim of the meeting was to present and debate on ENACT energy auditor profile and training programme-result of ENACT project. Several technical aspects regarding the energy efficiency in building was presented by the experts from KAPE as an additional substantive value. Participants could listen to interesting prelection describing new norm 16247 which included differences between understanding of energy audit definition and new competences for energy auditor.

Expert on energy efficiency in building had a lecture about technical conditions to be fulfilled by buildings in the perspective of 2021 and present differences between energy audit scope according to accessible financial programmes in Poland.

Then participants could hear about correct procedure of conducting energy audit and some interesting cases done by KAPE.

At the end phd Arkadiusz Węglarz gave interesting presentation about different kinds of modern termoinsulation and ways of improving energy efficiency.

Mr Węglarz was also the moderator of discussion which took place at the end of the meeting. Discussants tried to answer on several questions, among others:

- Is there a need for energy advisor in case of energy-saving and passive buildings?
- Is there a place for ENACT Energy Auditor on polish market?
- Will certification of ENACT Energy Auditor help or complicate work?

The content was prepared to facilitate discussion on the professional figure of the ENACT energy auditor and the results of realized project activates.

2. Target audience - potential beneficiaries (who were the stakeholders of the event; interested in ENACT and why)?

A total of 53 attendees participated in the event, including:

- energy auditors;
- professors/ lecturers from higher education;
- professionals working in the energy efficiency sector (Building Engineers, Technical Architects, Energy managers);
- entrepreneur from brands associated with energy usage;
- civil servants dealing with energy.

The beneficiaries of event was mainly the stakeholders connected with energy efficiency market and education cause. The aim of meeting was facilitation of discussion on content proposed in ENACT profile and training programme (O1 and O2 results) .

3. How was the ENACT project disseminated? (i.e. lectur on the project, distribution of material, promotion of website and social accounts, etc.)

The invitation to the meeting was sent via email to the huge group of KAPE and KIG partners/collaborants.

KAPE placed the information about the meeting on the website www.kape.gov.pl, www.energia0.pl and through the Facebook funpage (print screens in attachment)

Maria Dobrowolska (project manager in KAPE) presented an overview of the project, its aims and objectives, results achieved so far from O1, O2 and O3, expected outcomes and also an overview of the Polish national context (PowerPoint presentation).

After the meeting all registered people (53) received via electronic post set of presented materials (power point presentations). At the end of the event participants were asked to fill in a satisfaction questionnaire.

4. Short feedbacks, conclusions and possible follow-up

As mentioned previously, participants were asked to complete a short questionnaire in order to assess their satisfaction of the event and collect feedback about the project. A total of 28 questionnaires were collected.

Regarding the event, it is possible to conclude that participants were satisfied with its organization. All participants assessed the organization of the event as very good (60,7%) or good (39,3%).

The similar satisfaction level was perceived for the agenda, contents and materials distributed, with all participants or the vast majority of participants assessing these aspects as very good or fair.

Considering the participants' opinions about the project, one can say that it was well-received by assistants.

The majority of participants (89,3-96,4%) considered the project objectives, the results achieved, the methodology used and the ENACT figure to be very good or good.

In 3rd part of Questionnaire participants answered for 4 questions which aim was to get know about their opinion on ENACT energy auditor profile.

Most of the participants consider ENACT Energy Auditor necessary on Polish building market (78,1%). They also think that the energy auditor has the possibility to develop on residential building market (100%), and that there will be a need for their services (100%).

Most of the participants are interested in course and certifications of the energy auditor (67,9%).
